These services are available to help older adults and those with disabilities live safely and independently in their own homes through services paid for by Medicare, Medicaid, other federal and state resources, as well as private pay.

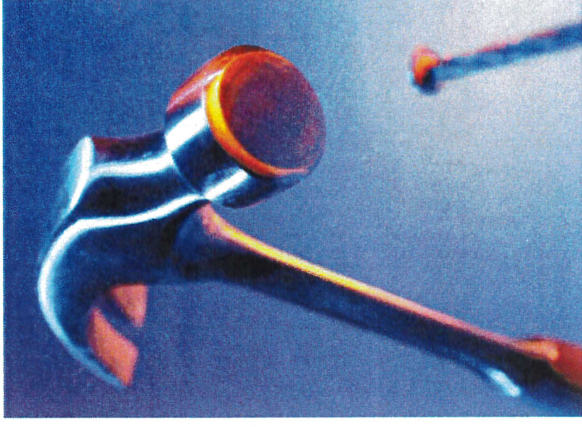


Those interested in learning more can call the Agency and speak directly with a nurse or social worker who will assist them with information surrounding the programs and services that are available to best serve their needs.

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Home Repair Services

Services provided through the Home Repair Program include home modification and/or repairs for:

- Heating Systems
- Plumbing and/or Septic Issues
- Hot Water Tanks
- Water Taps and Lines
- Hazardous Electrical Systems
- Severly Deteriorated Roofs, Walls, Floors and Doors
- Ramps for Handicapped-Accessibility
- Kitchen and Bathroom Modifications for Handicapped-Accessibility

** Weatherization and/or beautification services can not be provided under this grant.*

** Some repairs subject to waiting list.*

Eligibility

To receive services through the Home Repair Program, the following criteria must be met:

- Age 60 or older.
- Housing Assistance Grant - income of entire household must be at or below 50% of the county's median income.
- Senior Community Services Home Repair (Handyman Program) - income of entire household must be at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level.
- Must live in the home where modification/repair will be completed.
- Homeowner must be listed on deed, have life estate or life lease.
- Must complete application, sign appropriate release forms, and provide proof of income and ownership.
- Some restrictions apply to mobile homes.
- Repair allowed for residence only.
