A Resolution for the continuation of the existing levy of the additional sales tax pursuant to R.C. 5739.026(A)(6) for the implementation and operation of the County 911 Emergency System.

WHEREAS, the Brown County Board of County Commissioners, having determined the county's present tax revenues are insufficient to insure the proper fiscal implementation and operation of the County 911 Emergency System; and

WHEREAS, R.C. 5739.026(A)(6) permits the Board of County Commissioners to levy a tax of up to one-half of one percent upon every retail sale within the county, except sales of watercraft, outboard motors required to be titled pursuant to Chapter 1548 of the Ohio Revised Code, and sales of motor vehicles, to pay the expenses of the administration of the tax and to provide revenue for the implementation and operation of a County 911 Emergency System.

WHEREAS, the Brown County Board of Commissioners finds that the continuation of the original levy of a sales tax, pursuant to R.C. 5739.026(A)(6) will expire after the 2018 tax year, and that it is necessary to levy the sales tax of one-fourth of one percent for an additional five year period, for the purposes of the implementation and operation of the County 911 Emergency System.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Brown County Board of Commissioners, with at least two-thirds of its members concurring, that it is necessary to levy a sales tax of one-fourth of one percent on all retail sales and corresponding use tax, upon those transactions, uses, or other consumption as defined in R.C. 5939.026(A) and 5741.023, for the benefit of Brown County, Ohio, and for the purposes of implementing and operating a 911 Emergency System within Brown County, Ohio pursuant to R.C. 5939.026(A) and 5741.023, beginning and covering the following tax years: 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, and 2023, which levy shall be a continuation of the existing sales tax of one-fourth of one percent for the implementing and operation of the County 911 Emergency System.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board of Commissioners certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of Elections for Brown County, Ohio prior to the time required by law and notify the said Board of Elections to cause notice of election of the question of the levying of said sales tax to be given according to law and place the question of said tax levy on the May 8th, 2018 primary election ballot, pursuant to law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board of Commissioners be directed to notify the State of Ohio Tax Commissioner in writing of the said tax to be submitted to the electors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be put in to effect pursuant to R.C. 5939.026(A)(6) on the first day of a calendar quarter next following the 65th day following the date the Board of Commissioners and Tax Commissioner receive from the Board of Elections the certification of the results of the election.
