| WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code Section 5589 and 5543 provides to the Board of County<br>Commissioners, the authority to control any digging and excavating on or along a County maintained<br>highway and for the placement of a private driveway approach to a County maintained highway;<br>and,  |
