WHEREAS: The Board of Commissioners has received a request from Vernon Uchtman, landowner, for support of an application on their behalf to the State of Ohio for the purchase of 53 acres +/- of land by the Cardinal Land Conservancy, Inc. **Attachment A** to this Resolution is incorporated by reference and lists their respective properties.

WHEREAS: The Commissioners have reviewed this request and have determined that the nomination of the property for the 2017 Clean Ohio Conservation Fund program is compatible with the long-range goals regarding greenspace preservation for the county and respective township; and,

WHEREAS: The Commissioners find the request for the preservation of the property as open space and natural habitat, per the requirements of the Clean Ohio Conservation Fund program, and acknowledges that the landowner commits to donate at least 25% of the property value as match for the project costs; and
