The undersigned being all of the owners of the real estate in the unincorporated territory of the township hereby requests the annexation of that territory to the Village of Mt. Orab, Brown County, Ohio pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 709.02, 709.021, and 709.023.

- A. There are three owners of the real estate in the territory proposed for annexation. They are William B. Lucas, Trustee and James R. Lucas, Trustee, William B. 
